And God, I know I'm one.

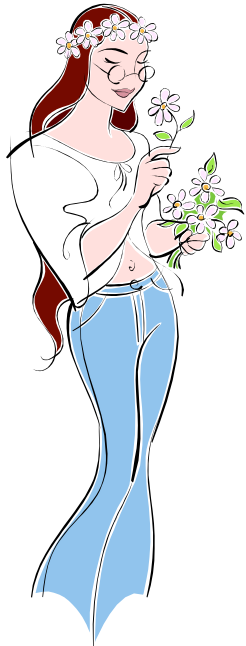

Division C: Catamarans. Helms person to be 50 or older, no age limit for crew.

All Divisions eligible for spot prizes. A and B Divisions are eligible to win 'Overall Regatta Trophy'.
Only Division A eligible to win 'Old Salts Trophy'. Only C Division eligible to win Catamaran Trophy.
